

STUDENT ART CONTEST - \$500 GRAND PRIZE

Submit a work of art for VOICES of Kentuckiana's 2nd Annual Student Art Contest. Selected pieces of art will appear in the Kentucky Center lobby at VOICES concert WE BELONG-Changing Hearts on Sunday, April 14, 2019.

CONTEST RULES

- 1. The contest theme is WE BELONG TOGETHER—Changing Hearts
- 2. The contest is open to students (K-12) from the Louisville area.
- 3. Entries should be no larger than 24 x 36 inches and no smaller than 8 x 11 inches.
- Entries must be submitted by Friday, March 1 and can be hand delivered to Kore Gallery at 942
 Kentucky St. or sent through the JCPS Pony to Lowe Elementary School, Sara Moses, Art Teacher.
- 5. Entries must have a label on the back with the name of artist, family address, family phone, family e-mail, and school.
- 6. Entries must be accompanied by a 10-50 word artist statement which shares a few thoughts about the piece. Judges will consider your title and artistic statement to learn more about your original work and creative interpretation of the theme. Give your work a title that stands out and describe how your work relates to your own personal interpretation of the theme.
- 7. Only original artwork will be accepted.
- 8. Selected pieces of art will be displayed at The Kentucky Center for the Performing Arts on Sunday, April 14, 2019 and all entries will be on the VOICES of Kentuckiana website for a full year www.voicesky.org

- 1. Elementary school: through grade 5
- 2. Middle school: grades 6-8
- 3. High school: grades 9-12
- 4. Special artist: all grades

PRIZES

Division winners: \$100 check
 Grand Prize winner: \$500 check

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ARTWORK

- 1. JCPS teachers may submit student work through the pony to Sara Moses at Lowe/146.
- 2. Artwork and entry forms can also be dropped off at Kore Gallery located at 942 E. Kentucky St. Hours are from Tuesday-Friday 11 am 6 pm; Saturday from 11 am 5 pm; and Sunday from Noon 5 pm.
- 3. SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Friday, March 15, 2019

HELPFUL TIPS!

Here are some questions to guide you in writing your Artistic Statement:

- How does your work relate to the theme of WE BELONG Changing Hearts?
- What is your personal connection to the theme?
- What did you use to create your work (e.g. supplies, technology, etc.)
- Who or what was your inspiration?

What are the judges looking for?

Judges look for personal interpretations of the theme that best exemplify creativity and technical skill.

- Interpretation: How closely does the piece relate to the theme, based on the work itself and the artist statement?
- Creativity: How creative and original is the piece in its conception of the theme?
- Technique: The level of skill demonstrated in the basic principles/techniques of visual arts.
